Our funeral directors will advise purchasers at the time of arrangements are made if any legal or other requirements mean additional supplies or services must be or should be purchased.

STAFF AND FACILITIES BASIC FEES

*** Basic Staff and Professional Fees**

*** \$890.00**

This service includes, but is not limited to, the availability and work done by our funeral director on behalf of the purchaser. This would include the coordinating and directing the services of our staff and agents with those of the hospital, nursing home, cemetery or crematorium in picking up the remains from the place of death and making the necessary arrangements for final disposition. It also includes the services of our support staff in preparing contracts, correspondence and invoices and in placing notices, booking staff, vehicles, cleaning and maintaining the premises, staffing and office coverage.

***Documentation (includes but not limited to)**

*** \$295.00**

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation, documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country. As part of this service, we will provide you with 12 proof of death certificates; such certificates are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial Death Certificate will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General, as well as all aftercare assistance required (CPP/ OAS/ other aftercare documents)

***Initial Transport of remains**

*** \$395.00**

Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital to our premises, or from our premises to the cemetery or crematorium using a transfer vehicle, for distances not exceeding 25 k.m. a charge applies for each transportation request. *Additional charge for distance (mileage) (\$3.25 per kilometer) one way.*

***Essential Care and Preparation**

*** \$110.00**

These services may include, when necessary, cosmetology, dressing of body, hair dressing, placing the body in the casket or cremation container, special care of autopsied remains, sanitation and exterior disinfection of the body when no embalming is authorized.

****Basic Facilities:**

*** \$345.00**

This is a minimum charge made by us in all cases for the use of our facilities. Use of our general and common areas, parking lot, public washrooms, cloakrooms, heating, lighting and maintenance. Includes cleaning and sanitizing equipment and providing Personal Protective Equipment. This charge applies whenever we provide services to you.

Including but not limited to transportation of remains to crematorium, delivery of cremated remains and other items to ceremonies off site, transportation of our staff to be pallbearers, any and all services required to register a death.

Funeral Coach/Hearse **\$325.00**

The use of this vehicle includes the transportation of the deceased from our facility to the place of the Funeral rite and to the place of final disposition. This vehicle will also be used for the safe and respectful delivery of Remains to crematoriums, other funeral homes, airports or any other destination.

Clergy/Lead Vehicle **\$140.00**

The use of this vehicle may include any or all of the following uses: transportation of clergy to funeral home or place of funeral rite, transportation of clergy to place of final disposition, leading of funeral procession.

GENERAL DUTY // DELIVERY Vehicle **\$145.00**

A general duty vehicle is used to support services by transporting staff, equipment, and necessary items to and from different locations, helping ensure any and all services are carried out smoothly and on time.

Family Vehicle/Pallbearer Vehicle **\$225.00**

A family/pallbearer vehicle is provided to transport specified people comfortably and respectfully to and from locations, allowing them to remain together throughout all events.
